The Europe for Citizens Programme aims at encouraging EU citizens to play a greater role in the development of the European Union and to bring Europe closer to its citizens. By funding projects in which citizens can participate, the Programme is promoting Europe's shared history and values, and a sense of ownership.

WHAT DOES IT SUPPORT?

EUROPEAN REMEMBRANCE

Support for projects reflecting on the causes of totalitarian regimes in Europe's modern history, and for projects concerning other defining moments in recent European history.

DEMOCRATIC ENGAGEMENT AND CIVIC PARTICIPATION

Support for projects allowing citizens to participate in the democratic life of the EU, ranging from local democracy to empowering citizens to play a full part in EU policy. Supported activities: town twinning, networks of towns and civil society projects.

FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES

TOWN TWINNING PROJECTS

Bring together citizens from twinned towns to debate issues on the European political agenda and develop opportunities for citizen engagement and volunteering at EU level.

NETWORKS OF TOWNS

Towns are encouraged to cooperate with other towns on a long-term basis to explore agreed subjects, share resources or interests, gain influence or face common challenges.

CIVIL SOCIETY PROJECTS

Give citizens an opportunity to participate effectively in EU policy making, stimulating debates and proposing practical solutions through cooperation at European level.

maximum €150 000

EUROPEAN REMEMBRANCE PROJECTS

Initiatives reflecting on the causes of the totalitarian regimes that blighted Europe's modern history, looking at its other defining moments, and considering various historical perspectives.

Deadline
Every 1 March

Grant amount:
maximum €100 000
